SUBJECT: **MEMO #17-02 – RATES OF REIMBURSEMENT (7/1/16 to 6/30/17)**

The annual adjustments to the nation average payment rates for meals served in day care homes and the administrative reimbursement rates for sponsors of day care homes have been published by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).

These rates of reimbursement are effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 for the Family Day Care Food Program. Rates are adjusted for inflation and rounded down to the lower whole cent for all meals served in both Tier I and Tier II day care homes.

This notice announces the annual adjustments to the national average payment rates for CACFP meals and supplements served in child care centers, outside-school-hours care centers, at-risk afterschool care centers, emergency shelters, and adult day care centers. The rate for Lunch/Dinner does not include the cash-in-lieu of USDA Foods rate, which sponsors receive as additional assistance for each lunch or supper served to participants. This is a decrease of three quarters of a cent from the school year 2016 (July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016) rate.

The payment rates for the period July 1, 2016 - June 30, 2017 are:
