

Adolescent Housing Hub

The Adolescent Housing Hub (AHH) is a real-time bed tracking and referral system. Provided through a partnership between the New Jersey Department of Children and Families (DCF) and PerformCare, AHH helps homeless youth quickly and conveniently find nearby housing.

AHH monitors housing program use and logs each youth's housing, employment, and education status at the time of admission and discharge. DCF has 368 units for DCF-involved and non-DCF-involved youth. Housing programs listed by AHH are contracted through DCF and serve youth ages 16 to 21.

AHH is used by:
