<p><u>Design of Graphic Organizer</u> type and number of linking lines used color and size of symbol number of graphics; format font type, size, color and style (bold, <i>italic</i>, and <u>underline</u>)</p>	linking lines are confusing; graphics are excessive and/or are illogically placed and may need to be sized; Difficult to read due to the colors or the size and format of the font; more than two different fonts used	linking lines are appropriate; graphics are appropriate and logically placed but may need to be sized text is easy to read; uses no more than two different fonts	linking lines aid comprehension; graphics are appropriate, logically placed and sized on the page; clean design makes it easy to comprehend the information; uses no more than two different fonts
