

MIDDLE SCHOOL WITH SUBJECT MATTER SPECIALIZATION: WORLD LANGUAGE GRADES 5-8 OTHER WORLD LANGUAGES (1191)

In order to be eligible for the Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing (CEAS), you will need to apply and meet the following requirements:

TO AVOID DELAYS:

1. Apply online at <http://www.nj.gov/education/educators/license/tcis/>
2. **After applying online, please submit ALL necessary documentation together IN A SINGLE PACKET to the NJ DOE.** For this certificate, you will need to submit the oath of allegiance/verification of accuracy form available under “Forms and Documents” on our website, official transcripts, and verification of program completion form (if applicable). If possible, please have transcripts sent to you first and then forward them in the [sealed envelope\(s\)](#) together with any other documents.
3. Please put your tracking number OR your Social Security number on all documents that you send us.

Degree Requirement

- A minimum of a bachelor’s degree is required for New Jersey professional educator certification.

Regional Accreditation

- New Jersey requires that all course work/degree appear on a regionally accredited, four year college or university. The following accreditation associations are approved by the State of New Jersey:

Certification

- Effective July 2, 2013, regulations for certification require that applicants hold an Elementary School or N-12 subject matter endorsement in order to be eligible for Middle School with Subject Matter Specialization Certificate. Issuance of the Middle School with Subject Matter Specialization certificate will be contingent upon eligibility and/or issuance of the Elementary School or N-12 subject matter endorsement.

Subject Matter Preparation

- Current regulations for certification require that applicants complete a minimum of 15 credits in OTHER WORLD LANGUAGES. Courses in OTHER WORLD LANGUAGES educational pedagogy do not count towards the subject matter requirement. **All credits must appear on a regionally accredited 4-year college/university transcript. If courses are taken at a community college, those credits must be transferred to a regionally accredited 4-year college transcript.**

Professional Teacher Preparation

- Current regulations for certification require that applicants complete a coherent sequence of study in professional education which may be completed in a provisional teacher program or an approved teacher preparation program.

This is to advise that courses presented by the applicant in professional education must be a coherent sequence of courses that culminates in supervised student teaching.

Course in the Characteristics of Young Adolescents Requirement

- A course in “Adolescent Psychology”, or its equivalent, that appears on a regionally accredited, four-year college or university transcript is required. **If this course is completed at a community college, it must be transferred to a regionally accredited 4-year college transcript.**

Test Requirement

- There is no Praxis II required for this endorsement.

Oral Proficiency Interview

- The Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) in the desired language with a score of “Advanced Low” or higher is required, if a test is available. Please consult with the NJDOE if Language Testing International does not offer the test you require. You must possess linguistic competency in the designated world language as demonstrated on a Department-approved, nationally recognized test of oral language proficiency for spoken language, reading/writing proficiency for classical languages or receptive/expressive proficiency for American Sign Language. Second Language Acquisition & Related Methodologies

- Please note that before a CEAS or *standard* certificate may be issued, a minimum of three semester-hour credits in second language acquisition theory and related methodologies offered by a regionally accredited four year college or university must be completed. A list of approved courses to meet this requirement can be accessed at the following website: www.state.nj.us/njded/aps/cccs/wl/courses.htm. **This course is not required in order to receive a CE.**

Physiology and Hygiene Requirement

- This may be completed by presenting evidence of basic military training, OR by completing a course such as biology, health or nutrition that appears on a regionally accredited 4-year college or university transcript, OR by completing a 35 question True/False test administered in the county office of education. ****I have read the requirements above and have applied. What are the next steps?**

1. You may check your application status online at any time: https://www20.state.nj.us/DOE_TCIS_ONLINEED/login.jsp Once all your application materials have been received and uploaded, the status of your application should change from INCOMPLETE to IN PROCESS. Please allow up to 15 days from the time that you send your application materials for the status to change to IN PROCESS. Once your application is IN PROCESS, please allow for an **8 to 12 week response time** depending on the type of certificate you apply for and the time of year that you apply. **Summer is the busiest time of year with correspondingly longer waiting periods.**
2. If you are eligible for the certificate, you will receive the certificate in the mail. If you are not eligible, an official evaluation will be sent to you via email. In order to update your email address on TCIS, please RE-REGISTER on TCIS. This applies to applicants who have already created a user id.

Online Certificate Information

- All information about certificates is now available online, including certificate name, certificate ID number, date of issuance, and expiration date if applicable. Instructions to view this information can be found at www.state.nj.us/education/educators/license/tcis/instructions.pdf.
- In order to make certification information available more quickly, this information will appear on our website in lieu of the issuance of paper certificates. Additionally, the move to electronic certificates will save costs associated with printing and mailing, as many of our neighboring states have discovered. **Therefore, as of May 15, 2015, paper certificates will no longer be issued.**
