Licensure Requirement Details

Family and Consumer Sciences: Child and Family Development #1706

Prepared by the Office Career and Technical Education

The holder of a **Family and Consumer Sciences: Child and Family Development Career and Technical Education Certificate #1706** issued by the New Jersey Department of Education is authorized to teach the following subjects in all public schools:

- *Family relations and human development, including parenting education, child care and development, and operating a nursery school in a high school classroom environment;*
- *Developing skills needed to deal with crisis in families;*
- *Handling children with special needs;*
- *Managing family economics and resources; and*
- *Providing career related instruction.*

The holder of this certificate is also authorized to teach the following career and technical education programs and programs of study in all public secondary schools:

- ***Child Care Provider/ Assistant, CIP Code 19.0709:*** *A program that prepares individuals to be primary providers of home, family, residential, or institutional-based child care services. Includes instruction in child growth and development, nutrition, recreation, planning and supervision of play and learning activities, child abuse and neglect prevention, parent-child relationships, and applicable legal and administrative requirements.*
- ***Child Development, CIP Code 19.0706:*** *A program that focuses on the intellectual, social, emotional, and biological development of children and the planning and design of related human services. Includes instruction in parent-child relations, parenting practices, special needs of children, parental and environmental influences on child development, external support services, and related public policy issues.*
- ***Developmental Services Worker, CIP Code 19.0710:*** *A program that prepares individuals to apply practical knowledge and skills to support individuals with a variety of physical, mental or developmental disabilities in a family or community setting. Includes instruction in health care, basic nutrition, pharmacology, nursing, autism, mental health, psychology, sociology, behavioral analysis, communication, intervention, counseling and community services, and developmental services, such as literacy and life skills training.*
- ***Human Development and Family Studies, General, CIP Code 19.0701:*** *A general program that focuses on basic human developmental and behavioral characteristics of the individual within the context of the family. Includes instruction in the conditions that influence human growth and development; strategies that promote growth and development across the life span; and the study of family systems.*
