Licensure Requirement Details

### **Family and Consumer Sciences: Foods/Nutrition and Food Science #1707**

The holder of a **Family and Consumer Sciences: Foods/Nutrition and Food Science Certificate #1707** issued by the New Jersey Department of Education authorizes the holder to teach the following subjects in all public schools:

- Nutrition, individual and family food preparation
- Food science
- Managing time and resources related to food preparation, and
- Exploring careers in foods and nutrition related occupations in all public schools

The holder of this certificate is also authorized to teach the following career and technical education program and program of study in all public secondary schools:

- ***Foods, Nutrition, and Wellness Studies, General, CIP Code 19.0501.** A general program that focuses on the role of foods and nutrition in human health and wellness. Includes instruction in nutritional care and education, the planning and provision of food services, the development of consumable food products, life-span nutrition and wellness, the principles of nutritional assessment, and food safety and food composition.*
