Complete a department approved second language acquisition/ methodology course. 	<p>Teachers holding this certificate may teach a world language in grades 6 – 8 self contained or departmentalized more than half time if they:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and receive a rating in the Advanced proficiency range*; <u>and</u> 2. Complete a department approved second language methodology course; 	<p>Teachers holding this certificate may teach a world language more than half time in grades 6 – 8 if they:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and receive a rating in the Advanced proficiency range*; <u>and</u> 2. Complete a department approved second language acquisition/methodology course; <u>and</u> 3. Obtain the Middle School Endorsement in the world language which includes the following requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pass the Praxis; <u>and</u> • Complete 15 credits in the language they will teach; <u>and</u> • Complete a course(s) in child and adolescent psychology. 	<p>Teachers holding this certificate may teach a world language P-12 if they:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete 30 credits in the world language with 12 credits at the junior/senior level; <u>and</u> 2. Take the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and receive a rating in the Advanced proficiency range*; <u>and</u> 3. Complete a department approved second language acquisition/ methodology course; <u>and</u> 4.
