DOUGLAS BRUSTMAN : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of July 22, 2010, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit Douglas Brustman had forwarded. After pleading guilty to Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Brustman was court-ordered to forfeit his teaching certificates. Brustman currently holds a Teacher of Social Studies Certificate of Eligibility, issued in November 2000 and a Teacher of Social Studies certificate, issued in May 2003.

Brustman agreed to forfeit his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of July 22, 2010, the Board voted to accept Brustman's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8*.

Accordingly, on this 22nd day of July 2100 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Douglas Brustman's Teacher of Social Studies Certificate of Eligibility and his Teacher of Social Studies certificate be effective immediately.
