RUSSELL TYBUS : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of July 28, 2011, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that Russell Tybus had submitted. After being charged with Endangering the Welfare of Children, Tybus entered a plea agreement and was required to forfeit his teaching certificates. Tybus currently holds a Teacher of Music Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, issued in February 2007 and a Teacher of Music certificate, issued in June 2008.

Tybus agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of July 28, 2011, the Board voted to accept Tybus' relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8*.

Accordingly, on this 28th day of July 2011 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Russell Tybus' Teacher of Music Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and Teacher of Music certificate be effective immediately.
