JOHN FORMAN : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of November 1, 2011, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that John Forman had submitted. After being charged with Endangering the Welfare of Children, Forman entered a plea agreement and was required to forfeit his teaching certificates. Forman currently holds a Teacher of Medical Assisting Certificate of Eligibility, issued in January 2004 and a Teacher of Medical Assisting certificate, issued in September 2005.

Forman agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of November 1, 2011, the Board voted to accept Forman's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8*.

Accordingly, on this 1st day of November 2011 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of John Forman's Teacher of Medical Assisting Certificate of Eligibility and Teacher of Medical Assisting certificate be effective immediately.
