SEAN COGHLAN : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of February 28, 2013, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that the Essex County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Sean Coghlan. In November 2012, Coghlan pled guilty to Endangering the Welfare of Children. As part of his sentence, he was ordered to forfeit his teaching certificates. Coghlan currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-5 Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, issued in June 2010 and a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-5 certificate, issued in June 2011.

Coghlan agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of February 28, 2013, the Board voted to accept Coghlan's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8*.

Accordingly, on this 28th day of February 2013 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Sean Coghlan's Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-5 Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-5 certificate be effective immediately.
