

GENERAL INFORMATION


- 21st CCLC Summer Academies are open to all Freehold Borough students entering grades 4 through grades 8.
- 21st CCLC Summer Academies will run Monday - Friday from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM at the Park Avenue Complex beginning July 2nd through July 27th.
- 21st CCLC Intermediate School Academic Academy for students entering grades 7 and 8 in September 2012 will run Monday - Thursday from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM at the Park Avenue Complex beginning June 25th through July 27th.
- Freehold Borough Public Schools does NOT offer transportation. Program participants must arrange for their own transportation.
- All 21st CCLC Academies will have an academic component integrated into their program.
- Field Trip Fridays - Field trips will take place every Friday in place of the academies. No other program will be offered on those days. Field trips will be offered to all participants at an additional cost of \$10 per trip. Information will be sent home separately.

REGISTRATION

- Programs are available on a first come, first serve basis. Academies are limited to 20 per class and will only run with a minimum of 10 students. (Register early to avoid being closed out of programs.)
- Please fill out all forms completely, attach payment and return to the 21st CCLC office at 280 Park Avenue no later than Friday, June 8th.
- Those who are eligible for the academic programs will be contacted directly. Parent/Guardian requests will be considered.
- Fee: Academies are \$80 for each two-week session. Parents may register their child for both sessions and pay a reduced fee of \$130 for both sessions. **Please make checks payable to Freehold Borough Board of Education.** Scholarships are available upon request. Please contact the 21st CCLC office at (732) 761-2202.

WHAT TO BRING

- Children should wear cool comfortable clothing.
- Students should bring water bottles with them during the day.
- Free breakfast will be available from 7:30 - 7:50 a.m. for all students.
- A snack and drink will be provided during the program.
