Notice of Approval of Licensure Petitions

Take notice that in compliance with N.J.S.A. 52:14-34.4 et seq. (P.L. 1987, c. 7), the Secretary of Higher Education hereby publishes notice of the following approved petitions:

The Bard College at Simon's Rock's petition to offer an Associate of Arts Degree program at the Early College High School in Newark, New Jersey has been approved. The initial license is effective for a three-year period as of October 31, 2013.

Wilmington University's petition for re-licensure to offer previously approved bachelor's degree completion programs, credit-bearing college courses, and master's degree programs in New Jersey has been approved. This licensure is effective for a period of five years as of October 31, 2013, for the previously approved instructional sites in New Jersey located on the campuses of Burlington County College, Cumberland County College, and Salem Community College.

Wilmington University's petition for initial licensure to offer the Bachelor of Science in Information Systems Management, the Bachelor of Science in Media Design, and the Bachelor of Science in Web Information Systems, as well as selected undergraduate courses in business, criminal justice, and nursing, has also been approved. This licensure is effective for a period of five years as of October 31, 2013, for the instructional site in New Jersey located on the campus of Gloucester County College.

Lakewood, New Jersey This licensure is effective for a period of three years as of October 10, 2013.
